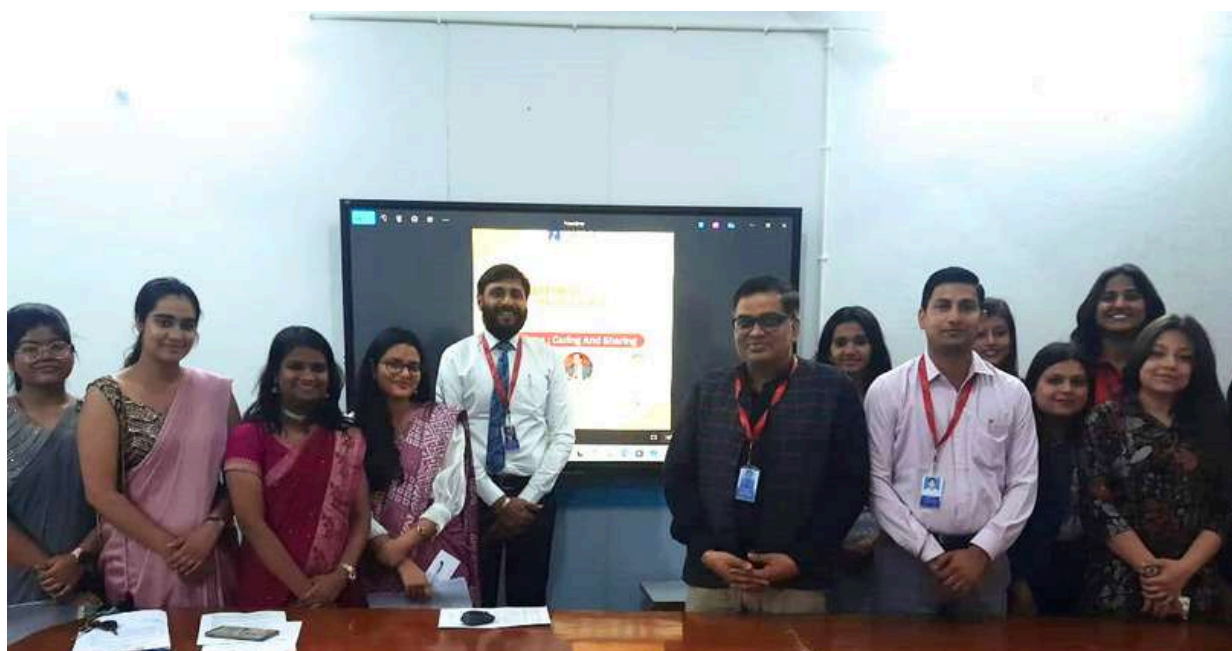
SHARDA SCHOOL OF PHARMACY CELEBRATED INTERNATIONAL DAY OF HAPPINESS 2K25
